

Recreational Trails Program

RTP is a federally-funded grant program of the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) that provides funds to states to develop and maintain recreational trails and trail-related facilities.

The minimum grant amount available is \$10,000, and the maximum is \$100,000 for *Nonmotorized* trail projects.

OHV trail projects are eligible for the maximum amount of *Motorized* funding available.





Who can apply?

- Local, State and Federal agencies
- Established nonprofit organizations
 - Must be a registered 501(c)(3) organization and provide copy of IRS tax exempt letter
- Established for-profit organizations • Must be "in the business of <u>recreation</u>"

*Nonprofit and for-profit organizations must have at least one full-time employee and operate recreational facilities open to the public.



Eligible Projects

Construction of new recreational trails

- o Hiking/walking
- o Cycling/mountain biking
- o OHV-use (ATVs and off-road motorcycles)
- o Kayaking/Canoeing
- o Horeseback riding/equestrian
- Maintenance and restoration of existing trails
- Development and rehabilitation of trailhead and trailside amenities

SCPRT will begin accepting Letters of Intent (LOIs) on Aug. 1, 2023.







Points of Interest

- RTP project agreement period is 18 months
- 25-year project compliance term
- Project sponsors must follow state procurement code and regulations
- RTP is a <u>reimbursement</u> grant that requires at least a 20% match project sponsor pays 100% up front RTP reimburses up to 80% of total project cost


